<p>QtWebkit is really outdated and seems to get removed from all major Linux distros. Of course, building LC without QtWebkit is totally possible right now, but it requires disabling certain crucial modules (ranging from Azoth to Kinotify). Ideally, we'd migrate away from QtWebkit to other alternatives, perhaps making it optional for those distros that still support it and those use cases where QtWebEngine is overkill.</p> <p>This (meta)issue tracks the migration progress and collecting all the child issues for specific tasks.</p>
